Catton Grove Community Centre – Catton Grove Community Lunches Our community lunches are held on the first Tuesday of each month. Our community lunches are very popular with an average 30-40 local residents attending. We offer a home-cooked 2 or 3 course meal, alongside a range of light snacks such as toasted sandwiches and jacket potatoes. We are looking for volunteers to help support the Community Lunches in a number of ways including food preparation, laying tables, serving meals, preparing hot and cold drinks and washing up. Training and ongoing support is available. No previous experience is required, we are looking for friendly, enthusiastic volunteers who enjoy working as part of a small team. Volunteers engaged in food preparation roles will need a Level 2 Food Safety in Catering Certificate, if you don't have one of these, we will arrange for you to attend a local training session or an online course if you prefer!

The Feed - Café Volunteers The Feed are looking for volunteers to help run their new café based in Waterloo Park. This is your chance to be part of a team developing this new venture set within the surroundings of one of the best parks in Norwich! As a volunteer you have the choice of helping to prepare food in the kitchen or being front of house helping to serve customers. The café is open 7 days a week. Typically, volunteer shifts are 4 hours either from 8.00am – 12noon or 12noon – 4.00pm, but we can be flexible to suit your availability. Previous experience in a café or restaurant setting is desirable but not essential.

Oak Grove Community Church - Foodbank Distributer On Tuesday evenings the Chapel acts as a distribution point for Norwich Foodbank. We are looking for volunteers to help support this activity by meeting and greeting members of the community who are visiting the foodbank and helping them to exchange their pre-awarded vouchers for a food parcel to meet their needs. We are looking for friendly, non-judgemental volunteers who are available on Tuesday evenings 5.00 – 8.00pm.

Oak Grove Community Church - Coffee Stop Helper Coffee Stop, which meets at the Chapel on Friday mornings, offers local residents the chance to catch up with friends and make new friends. We are looking for volunteers to help support the sessions by setting up the room and tidying away afterwards, meeting and greeting, serving light refreshments and chatting with anyone who is feeling lonely.
